

2021 Manassas Jazz Festival FAQ



1. When is the event?

Saturday, June 19th from 12 pm – 7 pm. VIP Entrance at 11am!

2. Do I need to wear a face mask and observe social distancing?

YES; temperatures will be checked at the gate

3. When can I get in?

The gates will open at 11:45 am for those that already have their tickets and for those looking to purchase tickets. *Tastings will not be given prior to 12 pm.*

4. How much are tickets?

Under 13 years old are \$1/person; in advance or at the gate.

Tasting Tickets are \$40/person; in advance (through AccelEvents) and \$45/person at the gate.

Non-Taster Tickets are \$25/person; in advance (through AccelEvents) and at the gate.

VIP Tasting Tickets are \$115/person; in advance (through AccelEvents) and \$130/person at the gate.

5. What is included in the ticket price?

Under 13 & Non-Taster tickets include entry into the event.

Taster tickets include entry into the event, a souvenir tasting glass and tastings from any of the participating tasting locations (wine, beer & spirits), as long as you have a tasting wristband.

VIP Tasting Tickets include early entry into the festival (11am), exclusive alcohol tastings not offered anywhere else in the festival, variety of food, all day tented seating, a swag bag, and prime seating to enjoy all of the music entertainment!

6. May I bring food into the festival?

Yes, you may bring food into the festival in a small bag or cooler. There will be multiple food vendors available too!

7. May I bring alcohol into the festival?

No, there is no outside alcohol allowed into the festival. There will be approximately 20 wineries, breweries, and distilleries represented for your tasting pleasure.

8. Will my bags be searched before I enter the festival?

Yes, all bags will be searched prior to entry to ensure that no unauthorized items are brought into the event.

9. May I bring a tent into the festival?

We kindly request that you leave your 10x10 (or larger) pop-up tents, canopies, quick-shade, etc. at home. This helps to ensure a quality viewing of the stage for all attendees. You may bring an umbrella or other shade device that will not obstruct the view of all attendees at the festival.

10. May I bring my own chairs?

Yes! Feel free to bring your own chairs and blankets to enjoy an afternoon of great music, food and libations on the Manassas Museum Lawn.

11. Can I bring my dog into the event?

Yes, dogs may be brought into the event, if they are leashed and well-behaved. We do desire to keep the festival clean and safe for all in attendance. It is required that all dog owners are respectful of the other attendees and clean up immediately after their dog, as needed.

*At the discretion of the Event Managers any misbehaved dogs or owners will be asked to remove the animal from the event.

12. What ages are allowed into the event?

All ages! Appropriate tickets are provided to all age groups. See question #3.

13. Does everyone need a ticket?

YES, (because of the pandemic). Every person under the age of 13 will need a \$1 ticket. Those over 13 will need a non-taster ticket. If over 21, you are eligible to purchase a taster ticket.

14. Do you offer refunds for tickets?

Per our current policy, we do not offer refunds for tickets (although exception has been made for pandemic cancellations). The event does have a rain date in case of *severe weather*, and the ticket would be honored on that date, should the event be re-scheduled.

15. What if it rains?

In the case of *severe* weather, the event organizers will make a decision whether the event will proceed or will be held on the following Saturday, June 26th (rain date).

16. Is there a rain date?

Yes. Saturday, June 26th. *This date will only be implemented in case of severe weather.*
